The Latino Roundtable of Southwestern Illinois was founded in 1992 and is a 501c3 nonprofit organization. Our mission is to work together to develop and expand available resources and to improve the delivery of social services to the Latino community through networking, advocating and providing services.

To apply for the college scholarship, the applicant must be a permanent resident of Madison or St. Clair counties in Illinois, must volunteer at a LRT event, have at least one grandparent who is Hispanic, currently attending high school in their senior year, and continuing their education at a post secondary institution. One or more \$500 college scholarships will be awarded based on funding levels.

2. A student should apply only if he or she is eligible.
3. Complete the application neatly and in its entirety.
4. Incomplete or late applications may be disqualified.
